Review Technical Standards

Team of 2 — This contest will follow the “Standards and Competencies” outlined within the SkillsUSA Technical Standards (virtual). Review the contest’s technical standards prior to competing.

Set Up Contest Space and Materials

The presentation must be filmed in a virtual environment (i.e. ZOOM, Teams, or Google Hangout). Actual visual aids may be used, or photographs may be shared via screen sharing.

Complete the Contest Submission

Your team will develop and execute a project in your community or school. Documentation or recording of the events will be maintained in an Electronic Notebook Presentation and a presentation video where your team will include an explanation of the purpose and scope of the project, how the project was developed, methods used, implementation and execution of the project and its results.

Electronic Notebook Presentation

Your team will create an Electronic Notebook as outlined within the SkillsUSA Technical Standards (virtual) and submit it as a PDF file.

Contest Team Presentation Video

Your team will submit a contest team presentation video in place of the “Presentation.” Your team should follow the outline provided in the SkillsUSA Technical Standards (virtual). Your video should be at least five minutes but not exceed ten minutes in length. The purpose of the presentation is to provide the judges with an understanding of the project, how the project was decided or determined, how it was completed, results achieved, and comments or recommendations for others to do a similar project. Someone can signal you at five, seven and nine minutes using the time cards provided.

Submit Contest Submission

Submit the following:

- Electronic notebook presentation.
- Contest video file.
- One-page typed resume.
