Review Technical Standards

This contest will follow the “Standards and Competencies” outlined within the SkillsUSA Technical Standards (virtual). Review the contest’s technical standards prior to competing.

Complete the Contest Submission

SkillsUSA Knowledge Test:

Students will complete the online SkillsUSA Knowledge Test by the contest deadline.

Skill Demonstration

On Wednesday of the state conference, the prompt will be posted on the Championship Hub. Students will have until 12 noon on Saturday to upload the URL to their final video.

This event is designed to evaluate excellence and professionalism in cinematography and short film production.

Students must provide (or have school provided) all of their own equipment. They are allowed to use audio, lighting, and grip equipment as outlined in the technical standards.

The camera shoot should be MANUAL mode, not automatic. Video should be shot in 4x3 or 16x9.

The final video should have 2 seconds of black frame and should not exceed five minutes. Any music or sound used must be from public domain or from a library service and must have reference at the conclusion of your video.

Files submitted must be in .MOV file type and compressed to H.264.

Submit Contest Submission

Submit the following:

1. A one-page resume
2. A final video up to 5 minutes in length
3. SkillsUSA Knowledge Test
